

# The Military Spouses Club of Yuma, Arizona 2022-2023 Scholarship Application

# **Conditions of Eligibility:**

- A. Scholarship(s) may be awarded to a dependent spouse or child of a qualified Military Sponsor attached to MCAS Yuma, or its tenant commands, and/or a dependent spouse, or dependent child of a **qualified military sponsor** whose residence at the time of application is within a 50-mile radius of Yuma, Arizona.
- B. Military Sponsors **MUST** fall into one of the following categories to qualify:
  - 1. Officer or enlisted military personnel on active duty or attached to a military installation located within a 50 mile radius of MCAS Yuma. 2. Officer or enlisted military retired personnel with an honorable discharge from active military service.
  - 3. Officer or enlisted military personnel who have separated from military service due to disability.
  - 4. Officer or enlisted military personnel who died while on active duty. 5. Officer or enlisted military personnel who died after retirement from the military as stated in '1' or '2' above.
  - 5. Officer or enlisted military personnel whose dependents reside in the area while the sponsor is on an unaccompanied tour or who remain to complete the school year after the transfer of the sponsor.
- C. Scholarships may be awarded to graduating high school seniors, GED recipients, and continuing education students (including higher education and/or trade school) attending an accredited college or university during the following academic year.
- D. Applicants may be considered on the basis of academia, extracurricular activity, work experience, community involvement/contribution, military community involvement/contribution, educational and professional goals, and essay composition.

#### **Financial Data:**

Awarded Scholarship funds will be sent directly to the school of the recipient's choice. The scholarship fund is non-deferrable and is to be used towards applicant's shared essay goals. The school shall be directed to use the funds solely to defray expenses only for the 2023-2024 school year.

## **Additional Information**

The Military Spouses Club of Yuma, formerly known as the Officers' Spouses' Club of Yuma, AZ, is a philanthropic organization benefiting local military families and their dependents. Funds raised at our events go toward our yearly projects that include holiday baskets, scholarships, and various charitable donations to other organizations that support military families. Since 2004, The Military Spouses Club has given over \$72,000 in scholarships to local Yuma military dependents and spouses.

# **Program Administration**

This program is independently administered by The Military Spouses Club of Yuma, a philanthropic organization solely responsible for the selection of scholarship recipients. #### **TRANSCRIPTS**

All applicants must attach one reference survey with their completed application. Surveys should be completed by a non-relative to highlight the applicant's strengths, character, and integrity. Surveys can be found at the end of this application.

Note to Applicants – Please request that your personal reference refrain from using any personal identifying information within the survey content including first and last name and unit affiliation.

#### **ESSAY**

The essay must be no more than 500 words, typewritten, double-spaced, no longer than 2 pages and stapled to this application. **Applicants must attach two (2) copies of their essay with their completed application**. Please place your name in the upper right hand header on only one (1) of your application essay copies. The second essay copy should have no identifying names within its headers.

# Note to Applicants – Please do not put any personal identifying information within your essay content.

- ◆ Proof of Conditions of Eligibility. One of the following must be provided: Photocopy (both sides) of applicants United States Uniformed Services Identification and Privilege Card
- Dependent Verification Letter. Must have authorized signature.
- Photocopy of current orders (Active Duty only) with SSN blacked out. Dependent's name must be listed and highlighted.
- Photocopy of retirement orders. Dependent's name must be listed and highlighted.
- Copy of DD Form 1300 or DD Form 214 signed by authorized signature. Supporting material listing sponsor and dependent's name if not listed on forms.
- One (1) copy of most recent education transcripts.
- Two (2) copies of one *personal reference survey*: one (1) copy with applicant's name listed in top-right hand corner, one (1) copy without applicant's name.

• Two (2) copies of completed essay: one (1) copy with applicant's name in top right hand corner, one (1) copy without applicant's name.
